WHAT IS A CHURCH BUILDING?

(Selected thoughts from Catholic Church Architecture & the Spirit of the Liturgy, by Denis McNamara, 2009, excerpts reprinted in The National Catholic Register, p. B3, 7-4-10)*

- A fulfillment of the ancient Jewish Temple & therefore a sacrament of the heavenly Jerusalem.
- The tabernacle is a fulfillment of the Ark of the Covenant.
- The altar rail is a vestige of the veil of the holy-of-holies in the ancient Temple.
- Sacred art & architecture are composed of signs & symbols of heavenly realities that lead the people to salvation.

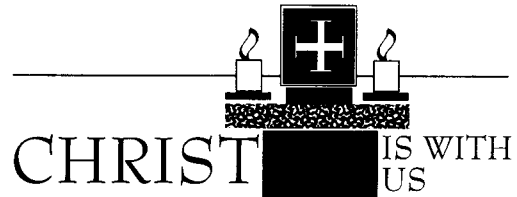
