In 20+ years of operation St. Peters School Lunch Program has not experienced many unresolved issues regarding unpaid/charged meals. However, the problem does occur and new regulations require stringent guidelines.

All families participating in the School Lunch Program are required to keep their account funded. Emails are sent when the account balance is low and will continue until a deposit is made. If the account becomes overdrawn a deposit will be required immediately. **Report cards will be held for all students with a negative balance. An account that is consistently overdrawn will necessitate a meeting with the School Lunch Program Administrator to discuss the situation.**

Software upgrades have made it possible for families to view their School Lunch Account on-line. Families are encouraged to check their account balance on a regular basis and pay attention to email notifications.

By working together the St. Peter's School Lunch Program will continue to provide nutritious, delicious, well-balanced meals at a reasonable cost.
